Lifelong fan Pete May relives nine classic finals when West Ham's bubbles nearly reached the sky, covering the chants, banners, dodgy hairstyles, celebrations and press reaction. West Ham played in the first ever game at Wembley, the 1923 FA Cup Final against Bolton. It saw a pitch invasion by 200,000 fans and brought celebrity to Billie the white horse. In 1964 the Hammers beat Preston 3-2 through Ron Boyce's late winner and Bobby Moore ran round the pitch with a giant hammer. A year later I'm Forever Blowing Bubbles rang round Wembley as Ron Greenwood's men conquered Europe, beating TSV Munich 1860 through Alan Sealey's double in a tremendous display of attacking football. Alan Taylor, a former mechanic signed from Rochdale, was the star of 1975 FA Cup Final, scoring twice as West Ham defeated Fulham, captained by former Hammers' legend Bobby Moore. In the 1980 FA Cup Final Johnny Lyall's claret and blue army were in the second division, but beat Arsenal through a rare Trevor Brooking header as Billy Bonds lifted the trophy for a second time. A year later West Ham took Liverpool to a replay in the 1981 League Cup Final, equalising at Wembley through Ray Stewart's dramatic last-minute penalty. When West Ham visited the Millennium Stadium in Cardiff for the 2006 FA Cup Final, it produced the most memorable final in recent history and a heartbreaking

penalty shoot-out defeat after a brilliant 3-3 draw. The Hammers returned to Wembley in 2012 after an absence of 31 years as Ricardo Vaz Te's late winner against Blackpool secured promotion in the Championship Play-off Final and resulted in Bobby Moore's statue being adorned with a claret and blue scarf. Nine great finals that sum up what it means to be a West Ham supporter. This series follows the exploits of seven football-mad kids - six boys, one girl - from a variety of ethnic backgrounds and, in the main, from single-parent or problem families, as they attempt to win the Little League cup and go on tour to France. As the year comes to an end, with all of us isolated from each other by this pandemic, I realize that the football club in which I have been heavily involved in is now 40 years old. I decided to put down in words those who care to share my memories of the club. The best place to start, so I'm told, is at the very beginning, so that would be 1976. (Yes, I know that is more than 40 years ago.) I had recently left lye town football club and really had no more interest in any involvement with football. Joan and I started to frequent the birch coppice pub on Friday nights, where we always met up with a great bunch of lads from quarry bank. Several of these lads all worked together at M&G trailers in lye and played for the local football team, Dunn's banks rovers. During a conversation, I was told the manager at M&G trailers wanted to speak to me. As I

pointed out, I was not looking for a job, so I inquired as to why he wanted to see me. It turned out he himself managed a local works team in Brierley hill and was looking for someone to take over the first team. My initial feelings were forget it, I'm not interested, but after several of the lads continuously bringing it up every week, it got to the point I said I would go along and meet this bloke, really, just out of courtesy. So up to the trailers I go, ask if I can see the works manager and become bombarded with questions: what's your name, have you got an appointment, what is it about. I was just about to say 'bollocks I'm off' when this bloke pops his head round the corner. "Are you Joe, I'm Alan bishop". That was the start of a great friendship with Alan and his wife Shirley. Through approximately 60 interviews with members of the British contingent who accepted the offer of the Yankee dollar, Playing for Uncle Sam recalls one of the most fascinating episodes in football history: the remarkable rise and chaotic collapse of the NASL. The FA Premier League was born 20 years ago, on 23 September 1991, and has since established itself as the most popular club competition in world football. At the start, however, there was opposition from the players' union and the Football League. Then the breakaway elite were faced with the exposure of the game's 'bungs' culture, which stained the reputations of Brian Clough and George Graham, among others. After weathering that storm, the new league was threatened again by the very real possibility of financial meltdown, which was averted only by the controversial takeover of many top clubs by

predatory overseas owners. Joe Lovejoy reported on the creation of the Premier League for *The Independent* and revisits the story in *Glory, Goals and Greed*, interviewing many of the 'founding fathers'.
